The original completed bid documents must be submitted in a sealed envelope endorsed with the Bid Number and Bid Description as detailed in the Tender Data. The sealed envelope must be deposited in the Bid/Tender Box, located in the reception area of Amatola House, 6 Lancaster Road, Vincent, East London, not later than the time and date specified on the cover page and SBD 1 of this bid.

Should a group of companies/firms and/or interested parties wish to enter into a joint venture / consortium agreement the following minimum requirements must be met: -

- a. A properly signed copy of the joint venture/consortium agreement must be attached.
- b. Each member of the joint venture/consortium's taxes must be in order.

Amatola Water invites quotations from suitably qualified and experienced service providers for the REQUEST FOR THE SUITABLY EXPERIENCED AND QUALIFIED PROFESSIONAL DRILLING SERVICE PROVIDERS FOR THE DRILLING, CONSTRUCT, AND YIELD TESTING OF SEA WELLS RAW WATER AT ALBANY COAST WTW.

Background:

Amatola Water is responsible for the operations and maintenance of Albany Coast Reverse Osmoses plant. The plant supplies Kenton on Sea, and Bushman's area. The plant receives water from 8 sea wells, which some are proving to be problematic. It is the wish of Amatola Water to drill new sea wells to augment raw water supply to the plant and thus improve the output volume treated water supply to the areas mentioned above. Thus, Amatola water invites qualified drilling companies to respond to their request for quotation for siting, drilling testing and equipping of the sea wells in Bushman's River Mouth.


SCOPE OF WORK

The RFQ is divided into two components and the specification for each component is indicated hereunder:

- 1) The planned drilling, construction, and development
 - Mud Rotary Drilling:
 - Depth = 20m
 - Diameter = 450 mm
 - Construction:
 - 250 mm OD / 227 mm ID PVC, flush threaded screw joins, no pop rivets
 - 0 8m solid
 - 8 20m perforated with 1mm slots and 5mm slot separation
 - Centralisers at 5, 10 and 15m
 - 1.2 2 mm washed silica gravel pack for 20 m
 - PVC end caps, top and bottom

- O Development:
 - 2 hours normal air flush, followed by 24 hours of venturi air development.
- Finishing:
 - Concrete block finish at surface.

2) The planned well testing

- Pump Installation Depth: <20 m
- Well Construction: 250 mm OD / 227 mm ID PVC, flush threaded screw joins, no pop rivets

o Development:

 2 hours normal air flush, followed by 24 hours of venturi airlift development.

o Testing:

- Step Test: 5 steps from 5 25 L/s
- CDT: 72 hours at up to 25 L/s, 150 m discharge line
- Observation Holes: 4 observation holes to be measured hourly for the first day and every 2 hours for the rest of the CDT (observation holes to be within 200 m of the test holes).

 Recovery: 2 hours for Step Test and 25 hours for CDT. All 4 observation holes to be measured hourly during 25-hour recovery.

Yield testing and water sampling analysis

- Equipment and compliance to industry standards
- Supervision during testing, step-test yield range instructions, selection of CD test rate and recovery periods.
- Maintain site instruction book
- Ensure correct water sampling procedure and delivery time to accredited laboratory
- Site inspection & handover ensuring boreholes are weld-sealed

Technical reporting

A detailed report summarising all relevant yield testing and water quality results will be submitted to the consultant and Amatola Water.

Where possible all casual labour must be sourced from the local community. Amatola Water will require a register of the people used on this project. The acquiring of local casual labour must be done through the Councillor or CLO of the project.

The tendered rates on the BOQ must include all vehicles, plant, equipment, travel, accommodation, specialised equipment and P&G needed to complete the scope of work.

The successful bidder will be required to submit Health and Safety Plan to Amatola Water for approval before contract starts.

The contractor should take full responsibility of any Incidents / Accidents on-site. Contractors to Comply with Health & Safety standards as per OHS Act 85 of 1993 & that of the CR2014.

The contractor must leave the site in a clean and neat condition on completion of this contract.

Any damages to the surrounding area, buildings, fences, equipment, infrastructure etc occurred during drilling or yield/aquifer testing will be the responsibility of the contractor to rectify such damage at their own costs.

Note: Amatola Water has the right to select any task or service or part thereof.

Payment will be made for task/services executed and not necessary the total order. Payment will be made within 30 days of the payment certificate/invoice being submitted to Amatola Water, subject to Amatola Water receiving payment from the Client.

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES
