3. RFQ Evaluation Criteria

BID SPECIFICATION

Amatola Water invites quotations from suitably qualified and experienced service providers for the REQUIRE A SERVICE PROVIDER TO REMOVE AND SAFE DISPOSAL OF ASBESTOS PIPES FROM LAING PIPELINE

BACKGROUND

Amatola Water is an Eastern Cape based state-owned water services utility (water board), established in 1997, in terms of the Water Services Act. Its prime function is to provide bulk water and sanitation services to water sector institutions, water service authorities and other customers as provided for in the South African water services legislation. Amatola Water's service area includes Buffalo City, the Amathole District and portions of adjoining districts in the central Eastern Cape.

The transportation, handling, removal, clearing and safe disposal of asbestos pipes and "off cuts" within Amatola Water need to conform to the requirements of the Occupational Health and Safety Act of 1993, Asbestos Abatement Regulations, 2020 and the Environmental Conservation Act, 1989 (Act No.73.1989).

These legislations and regulations require Amatola Water as the employer to use a reputable Service Provider for disposal of asbestos waste materials. Therefore, Amatola Water seeks to appoint a reputable Service Provider who is able to offer an extensive range of expertise in the field of Waste Disposal Management and the following:

- Has the ability to identify the applicable occupational health and safety legal requirements applicable to Amatola Water; and
- Has experience in the effective execution of handling, removing and disposing of asbestos pipes and collars (off cuts, full length)

SCOPE OF WORK TO BE PERFORMED:

The loading, transportation and disposing of 24 X 25cm X 5m AC asbestos pipes from Laing Pipeline area to an approved waste disposal site.

1. SITE

Appointed service provider to ensure that all asbestos waste on site is removed with one load.

2. TYPE OF VEHICLE

The Service Provider to ensure that a container or vehicle in which asbestos is transported is clearly identified in accordance with the UN Transport of Dangerous Goods or UN Orange Book.

3. APPROVED DISPOSAL SITES

The Appointed Service Provider shall ensure that the Port Elizabeth waste site is used for this Project.

COLLECTION OF ASBESTOS WASTE SHALL TAKE PLACE AT THE LAING PIPELINE.

4. TRANSPORTATION OF ASBESTOS WATE TO APPROVED DISPOSAL SITES

- 4.1.1 The Appointed Service Provider must be a "registered asbestos contractor" means either a contractor, a mandatory or an employer who conducts type 2 asbestos work or type 3 asbestos work or asbestos removal work, who is registered with the chief inspector: in accordance with the provision of the Occupational Health and Safety Act of 1993, Asbestos Abatement Regulations, 2020 and the Environmental Conservation Act, 1989 (Act No.73.1989).
- 4.1.2 The Appointed Service Provider shall comply with the requirements with respect to the transportation of dangerous goods in or on a vehicle on a public road, as determined in the applicable Codes and Standards.
- 4.1.3 The TRUCK Operator, (Consignor or Consignee), as the case may be, shall nominate a qualified person in the circumstances and with respect to the tasks pertaining to the transportation of dangerous goods, as determined in the standard specifications and Codes of Practice.
- 4.1.4 The Code and Standards require that before the commencement of loading, transportation operation, the Appointed Service Provider Operator shall ensure that agreements covering prescribed aspects of the operation are concluded between the relevant parties.
- 5.1.4 The Appointed Service Provider SHALL warrants that they will at all times, during the duration of this Contracts, comply with the Standard specifications and applicable Codes of Practice as they apply to the relevant party.

5. OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

- 5.1.1 The services provider shall be registered as a Waste Service Provider.
- 5.1.2 The services provider shall be registered and are in Good Standing with the Workman's Compensation Commissioner.

6. REQUIREMENTS FOR LABELING, PACKAGING, TRANSPORTATION AND DISPOSAL OF ASBESTOS.

- 6.1.1 The Service Provider shall provide evidence of safe collection and disposal by means of waste manifests and safe disposal certificates to Amatola Water before payment could be done.
- 6.1.2 The Service Provider shall ensure that asbestos materials are covered so as to prevent dust liberation during transit. Amatola Water personnel are to ensure that Service Provider do cover the asbestos waste prior to departure.

- 6.1.3 A disposal Certificate is obtained from the asbestos disposal site, for all asbestos waste removed from the workplace; all asbestos waste is disposed of only on sites specifically designated for this purpose in terms of the Environment Conservation Act, 1989, and the National Environmental Management: Waste Act, 2008.
- 6.1.4 The appointed Service Provider shall ensure that their employees involved in the transportation and dumping of asbestos waste are provided with the required respirators and protective clothing and they are properly trained in the procedure to be followed in the event of spillage or similar emergency or situation that could arise by accident.
