Amatola Water Board is a state-owned, South African water utility established in November 1997 and is mandated to render water services to water sector institutions, to local government and other customers in the Eastern Cape.

INVITATION AND SCOPE OF WORK

COMPULSORY BID CLARIFICATION MEETING

A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer will take place at NAHOON DAM BOAT HOUSE, EAST LONDON, Eastern Cape (Refer to below co-ordinates) on the **02nd March 2021** at 11:00am. Due to COVID19 pandemic regulations under Lockdown level 3, attendance will be limited to one representative per entity. Those parties arriving more than 15 minutes late from the starting time will not be allowed to attend the meeting. No tender documents will be sold at the clarification meeting.

BID CONDITIONS

• Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act 2000 (PPPFA) principles shall apply to this bid, whereby submissions will be evaluated accordingly to the provisions of the Act.

- Broad Based Black Economic Empowerment (B-BBEE) Status will be scored in accordance with the DTI Codes of Good Practice and bidders must submit their original and valid B-BBEE status level certificate or a certificate issued by a registered auditor, accounting officer (as contemplated in section 60 (4) of the Closed Corporation Act, 1984) or an accredited verification agency in order to be eligible for B-BBEE points.
- Amatola Water does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any tender and reserves the right to accept any tender or portion of a tender.
- Tenders which are late, incomplete, unsigned or submitted electronically will not be accepted.
- All tenders are to remain valid for a period of 90 days from the closing date of the submission.
- Failure to provide supplementary information specified and completion of the returnable schedules will result in the tender being regarded as non-responsive.
- Tender Forms (Form C1.1: Form of Offer and Acceptance) that are incomplete or incorrectly completed will result in the disqualification of the tender.

PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT POLICY FRAMEWORK ACT NO. 5, 2000 (PPPFA) WILL BE APPLIED AS FOLLOWS:

In terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act 2000 and Preferential Procurement Regulation 2017.

LOCAL PRODUCTION AND CONTENT

Declaration Certificate for Local Production and Content for Designated Sectors as Annexure C and Local Declaration Summary Schedule must be completed and signed and only locally produced goods, services or works or locally manufactured goods, with a stipulated minimum threshold for local production and content will be considered.

Tender offers will be declared non-responsive should they fail to comply with above requirement.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

The 80/20 preference points system as prescribed in the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017 Pertaining to the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, (ACT No 5 of 2000) (PPPFA) will be applied to evaluate all bids. The lowest acceptable bid will score 80 points for price and a maximum of 20 points will be awarded depending on the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment (B-BBEE) Status Level of Contribution. Bids received will be evaluated in two (2) phases; namely Mandatory Requirements and Price and Preference.

Responsive and qualified tenderers will be listed on a rotation in ascending order per area of works for the period of three years and be appointed on ad hoc basis, rates will be subject to negotiations.

BID PUBLICATION

Bid documents will be available from **11:00 on 25th February 2020** at Reception at Amatola House, 6 Lancaster Road, Vincent, East London and then during working hours between 08:00 – 16:00 until one week after Compulsory Bid Clarification Meeting. **A non-refundable fee of R200.00 is payable for each set of bid documents. Payment is to be made by either bank deposit or Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) only (no cash or cheque payments will be accepted) and is to be made payable to Amatola Water, Standard Bank, Account No. 080002277, Branch Code: 050021.** The proof of deposit is required upon collection of the tender documents. No tender documents will be sold at the briefing meeting.

BID SUBMISSION

The original completed bid documents plus one complete duplicate copy of Volume 1 of the original and all supporting documents (in a separate file), must be submitted in a sealed envelope or parcel endorsed with the Bid Number and Bid Description as detailed in the Tender Data. The sealed envelope must be deposited in the Bid/Tender Box located in the reception area of Amatola House, 6 Lancaster Rd, Vincent, East London, prior to the time and date indicated in the bid notice and the Tender Data. The bid submissions will be opened by Amatola Water SCM officials shortly after the closing time. No public opening of tenders will be allowed due to the resurgence of Covid 19 pandemic, however Tender offer results will be published onto Amatola Water Website within 30 days from the closing date.
