#### 1. Background

Amatola Water is state owned entity and is the largest water testing laboratory in the East London, responsible for testing of the raw, potable, and final effluent water. During water testing process, the lab makes use of different chemicals which create health risk to environment. Disposal of these chemical waste is critical for the health of our environment.

Amatola Water is sensitive to the environmental issue which includes land, rivers, and ground water contamination. Amatola Water's objective is to appoint service providers to provide the services described in this specification is to assist in correctly managing AW generated chemical waste through its proper removal from the premises and by the legally correct and environmentally sound transport and dispose the waste.

All processes and procedures required to be adopted, followed and / or implemented to ensure the safe and efficient removal of hazardous chemical waste from the facilities shall, in so far as not specifically addressed in this Project.

Specification, be performed and executed by the Service provider in accordance with Good Operating and Engineering Practices, the Necessary Consents and the Statutory Requirements. The Service Provider shall in the process of rendering the Services, be liable for damage done to any Amatol Water property.

#### 2. SPECIFICATIONS FOR REMOVAL OF GENERAL WASTE

#### 2.1. PURPOSE

#### 3. SPECIFICATIONS FOR REMOVAL OF GENERAL WASTE

#### 2.1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this document is to lay out the requirements for the removal and disposal of general chemical waste from Amatola Water Scientific Services, East London. The contract period will be for 5 years (60 months) on Rate Based.

#### 2.2. Scope of Work

- Collect and dispose the laboratory chemical waste in accordance with SANS 10228 ("Hazardous Substances")
- To minimise uncontrolled dumping of Hazardous Wastes, consignors and transporters must comply with the SANS 10406 on Transportation of Dangerous Goods
- Once the waste is properly disposed of at a suitable, permitted facility, a copy of the manifest must be returned to Amatola Water Scientific Services.
- Supply chemical waste containers which are manufactured from materials that can resist effects of
  the acids and alkaline waste and that can withstand the physical methods used for the handling
  and the transportation of the containers.
- Supply 20 litres containers with lids for waste storage.
- Supply 100 litres drums for the collection of both acid, salts and alcohol which will be then collected and dispose in a correct manner.
- The waste to be collected b-monthly or as an when required.
- Types of chemical waste generated by the laboratory: Alkaline, Chemical Oxygen Demand Vials (containing potassium dichromate K2Cr2O7) and Cuvettes waste (containing alkaline waste)

#### 3.1. Transport requirements include:

- the packaging/containerisation of the waste
- labelling of containers
- · vehicle requirements and licensing thereof
- driver training, licensing, and responsibilities (compliance certificate for transportation of hazardous chemicals to be attached as proof of compliance)
- loading of the vehicle and securing of the load
- placarding of the vehicle and transport documentation

#### 4. LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

The service provider must comply with the following Legislation / Regulatory requirements:

- 1) National Environmental Management Act: no. 107 of 1998 (NEMA)
- 2) National Environmental Management: Waste Act no. 59 of 2008 3) Occupational Health and Safety Act: no. 85 of 1993 (OHSA)

- 5) Permit to discharge industrial effluent in terms of Waste and Sanitation Services

#### 5. COLLECTION, TRANSPORT AND DISPOSAL

The collection and transport of waste from Amatola Water, Scientific Services Department to an approved waste disposal facility will be done by the service provider as specified by the National Environmental Management: Waste Act no. 59 of 2008, Part 5: Storage, Collection

and Transportation of Waste, through the use of their own vehicles which will meet with requirements as stated in the above-mentioned act.

#### 6. Frequency

Waste should be collected monthly or when need arise for disposal.

#### 7. WASTE STREAMS

Waste to be collected by the service provider will be defined as General Waste and will include the following:

#### SAFETY, HEALTH, AND ENVIRONMENTAL REQUIREMENTS

All activities conducted by the service provider and its personnel must be conducted in terms of the OHSA, NEMA and Amatola Water Health and Safety requirements, to prevent or acceptably control, impacts to the environment and people.

NOTE: Sub-contracting of services will not be permitted.

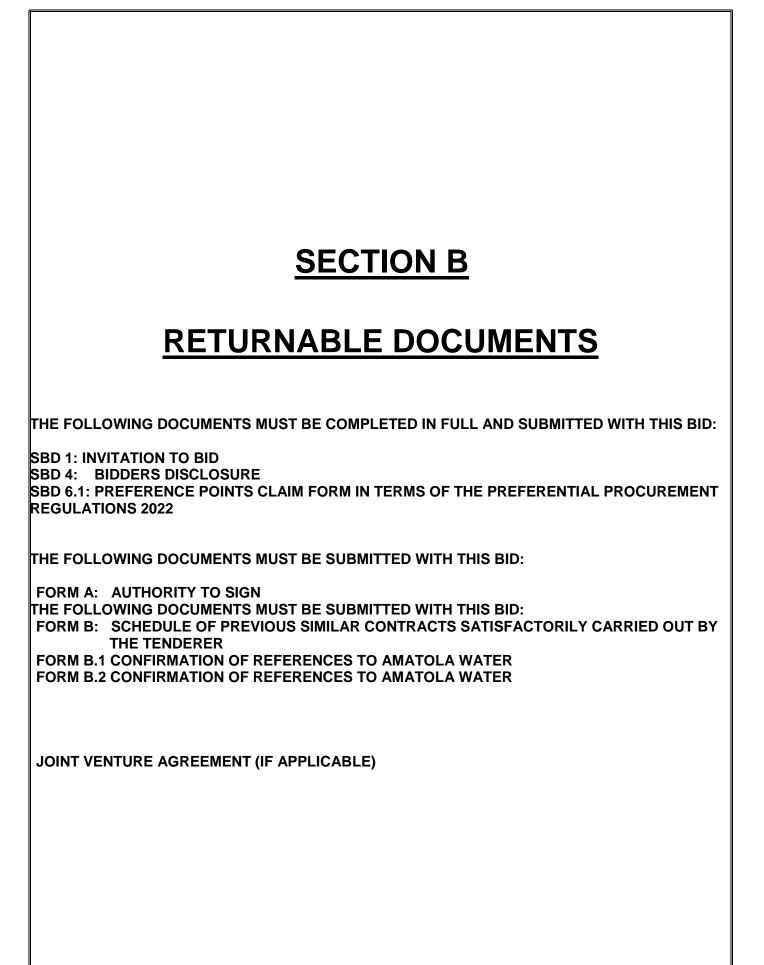
