1. BACKGROUND

Amatola Water is an Eastern Cape based state-owned water services utility (water board), established in 1997, in terms of the Water Services Act. Its prime function is to provide bulk water and sanitation services to water sector institutions, water service authorities and other customers as provided for in the South African water services legislation. Amatola Water's service area includes Buffalo City, the Amathole District and portions of adjoining districts in the central Eastern Cape.

2. <u>Scope</u>

Specification

The objective of the contract process is to appoint service providers to submit proposals for the Provision of Medium Size Excavator, an Operator and Lowbed services for the repairs to Mnyameni Raw water pipeline for Amatola Water in Keiskammahoek area of service with the specification as tabled below:

Excavator

Maximum Digging Depth: 6720mm Power: 128.5kW Operating Weight: 22500kg

The following is covered in the scope of work:

- The Plant machinery must be quoted on a hourly wet rate and have its own operator.
- Lowbed must be quoted on provisionally in the event the Lowbed needs to be transported or moved to or from site to your depot or to another location, (Note: Location of machinery will be closely monitored as per the preference area)
 - Km rate.
- The minimum normal hours per day shall be charged at eight hours (8 hrs) per full day.
- The operator must be competent to excavating within or between surrounding existing services and according to levels provided by the foreman or responsible person.
- The owner of the machine and the Rollback shall submit the daily working hours and kilometres of the machine and Lowbed every Monday of the week which hours will be compared with the records of the Amatola Water foreman or responsible person. Machine must be equipped with an hour meter which records only when engine is running.
- The operator of the machine shall comply with the Health and Safety regulations of the

Occupational Health and Safety act.

- Excavator and the Lowbed must be in a good road worthy condition.
- The service provider will submit a summary of the hours and kilometres worked and travelled
 or after the machine has been used, or after the contract period has seized, which will be
 certified for payment by the responsible person and Manager according to the weekly
 records.
- The successful service provider shall provide competent Excavator operator with fuelled Excavator who can excavate at prescribed slopes with the use of profiles on pipeline networks in the Keiskammahoek Mnyameni systems.
- The plant shall be requested on as and when required bases from the date and will be expected within 3 hours after the request. Security and liabilities of the Plant machinery will be the responsibility of the Plant Company. Amatola Water will not be responsible of any losses or damages to the machine caused by recklessness of the service provider.
- Any downtime of the Plant (Excavator) due to own problems e.g., operator not available on site, breakages etc. will be deducted from the actual hours worked and must be shown on the daily logbook for reconciliation purposes.
- Any breakages on the machinery on site, will warranty replacement of the machine and must be responded to within 4 hrs.
- Plant machinery must be available on site when requested by Amatola Water and supplied by the successful supplier outside of agreed working hours.
- Amatola Water reserves the right to increase or decrease the contract period or any part
 thereof if project work on the contract is cancelled or work has come to an end. This will be
 communicated to the contractor in advance when and for how long the contract will be
 stopped/cancelled/ceases.
