Form A must be completed. Failure to complete Form A will invalidate your bid.

#### 6. JOINT VENTURE REQUIREMENTS

<u>DEFINITION</u>:- "Joint Venture or Consortium": means an association of persons for the purpose of combining their expertise, property, capital, efforts, skill and knowledge in an activity for the execution of a contract.

Should a group of companies/firms and/or interested parties wish to enter a joint venture / consortium agreement the following minimum requirements must be met: -

- a. A properly signed copy of the joint venture/consortium agreement must be attached.
- b. Each member of the joint venture/consortium's taxes must be in order.
- c. After the award of a contract to a joint venture/consortium, the successful joint venture group or consortium must provide a combined joint venture/consortium Tax Clearance Certificate.
- d. After the award of a contract to a joint venture/consortium, the successful joint venture group or consortium must provide the details of the joint venture / consortium banking details.

#### 1. BACKGROUND AND INTRODUCTION

Amatola Water (AW) is an essential services utility operating in the water sector in the Eastern Cape. AW was established in 2007, in terms of the Water Services Act (Act 108 of 1997) and is accountable to the Minister of Water and Sanitation as its executive authority. The purpose of this document is to invite potential service providers to submit proposals for the provision of professional services related to the **design**, **layout**, **editing**, **proofreading and production support** of the Integrated Annual Report (IAR) for the **2024/2025** financial year.

The annual report is a key strategic document which reflects AW's operational performance, financial results, and sustainability impact. It also serves to reinforce AW's reputation for transparent, ethical, and sustainable business conduct.

#### 2. SCOPE AND DELIVERABLES

The selected service provider will be expected to deliver a fully integrated and visually compelling publication that is aligned with the AW's communication objectives and corporate identity, while meeting the highest standards of corporate reporting, environmental, social, and governance (ESG) disclosure and in compliance with applicable legislative and best practice requirements. The service provider must be capable of managing an end-to-end solution, including:

- Reporting strategy
- Content development and editing of the report and financial statements
- Designing and packaging the material in an interactive and digital format
- Ensuring compliance with leading reporting standards on environmental, social, and governance (ESG) criteria

The appointed service provider will be expected to deliver the following components as part of the integrated annual report production process for the 2024/25 financial year:

#### a. Case Study and Technical Review

The service provider must review AW's current Integrated Annual Report and Audited Annual Financial Statements (2024/25) as a case study. This assessment must evaluate alignment with the Integrated Reporting Framework, King IV Corporate Governance Principles, and General Recognised Accounting Principles (GRAP),

and inform the approach to be adopted for the current and future reporting cycles.

#### b. Copywriting, Editing and Proofreading

The appointed service provider will be responsible for the **copywriting**, **substantive editing**, **language refinement**, **and proofreading** of all content included in the Integrated Annual Report and Annual Financial Statements. This includes ensuring alignment with Amatola Water's approved tone, language style, and corporate branding guidelines, while maintaining consistency, clarity, and professionalism throughout the documents.

- Liaison with AW's internal teams for content integration and approval processes.
   The entity will provide the initial content for the Integrated Annual Report and retains full responsibility for the accuracy and integ
- rity of the information contained therein.

Furthermore, the entity will coordinate and secure all internal approvals, confirmations, and signatories required for the report, including those of the Chairperson, Chief Executive Officer, Board of Directors, and external auditors.

#### c. Executive Interviews and Statement Development

The appointed service provider must assign a **professional copywriter** to conduct **executive interviews** with key leadership, including the **Chairperson**, **Chief Executive Officer**, **and Chief Financial Officer**. Based on these engagements, the copywriter will be responsible for drafting the respective **executive statements** to be included in the Integrated Annual Report. The statements must accurately reflect the strategic intent, performance highlights, and governance perspectives of the Corporation's leadership, and must be aligned with the overall messaging and tone of the report.

#### d. Design and Layout

The service provider must manage the **creative concept development**, **design**, **and layout** of the Integrated Annual Report and Financial Statements in accordance with:

- The approved annual theme
- Cover and page template design in line with Amatola Water's corporate identity

#### **Deliverables must include**

- Draft versions of the report for internal review per reporting cycle

#### e. Design and Typesetting

The service provider will be responsible for the creative design and professional typesetting of the Integrated Annual Report, based on final, edited, and approved text

content. The provider must present a minimum of three (3) distinct design concepts, aligned with the approved annual theme and in strict adherence to the AW's corporate identity.


The service provider will report directly to the Corporate Performance Information Specialist of Amatola Water. The service provider will work closely with the office of the CE.
