1. BACKGROUND

Amatola Water is an Eastern Cape based state-owned water services utility (water board), established in 1997, in terms of the Water Services Act. Its prime function is to provide bulk water and sanitation services to water sector institutions, water service authorities and other customers as provided for in the South African water services legislation. Amatola Water's service area includes Buffalo City, the Amathole District and portions of adjoining districts in the central Eastern Cape.

2. SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of work for the PROVISION FOR CALIBRATION OF LABORATORY EQUIPMENT ON RATE BASED. The following areas have been scoped into this project. The selected bidder will be required to:

Request for Quotation for Servicing and calibration of various laboratory equipment, Scientific Services

Scope of Work

- The Service Provider will provide a SANAS accreditation certificate covering the scope of work to be tendered.
- The Service Provider is to provide SANAS calibration certificates on completion of work.
- Calibration certificates at a minimum should contain the Uncertainty of measurement on the equipment that was used, the Correction factors that are to be applied, and recommendations on how to correct these correction factors.
- The service provider is to interpret the calibration certificates for all equipment used by the laboratory staff.
- Should the Service provider consider subcontracting part of the scope, the subcontracted service provider is to be SANAS Accredited (proof of accreditation, scope, and certificate to be submitted).
- In the case of subcontracting, the service provider may not subcontract more than 10% of the work to be done.
